Guided Quad-bike Tours

R 400 PP/1st hr

R 250 PP /additional hours

Guided quad-bike tours explore the magnificent flora, birds and lagoon wetlands on Mosaic. The trip traverses limestone ridges and paths along the Hermanus Lagoon with beautiful mountain and lagoon views. Water is provided.

Boat Cruise on the Hermanus Lagoon

R 400 PP

1.5 hours

Board the "Spirit of Agnus" from the jetty at Mosaic for a pontoon boat cruise on the Hermanus Lagoon among a myriad of water birds and the towering Overberg Mountains. Canapes and house beverages/wine/beer are included. The boat seats 12 maximum. A minimum charge of 4 guests applies. Trips are weather dependent.

Beach Excursion:

R 400 PP 2 hours

Hop onto Mosaic's open 4x4 vehicle and discover fynbos, birds and the pristine Walker Bay Beach and Nature Reserve. Unique sightings are of the near-threatened Oyster Catchers, seals and Southern Right Whales, which migrate from Antarctica to the shelter of Walker Bay to court, mate, and calf. June-December. Snacks and house beverages/ wine/beer are included. The vehicle can seat a maximum of 9 guests. A minimum charge of 4 guests applies.

Fat Bike and Mountain Bike Rentals:

R 200 PP 4 hours)

R 350 (up to 8 hours)

For the cycling enthusiasts, the Fat Bikes are ideal for cycling from Mosaic to the Walker Bay Nature Beach, or on 30 km of roads on Mosaic. The rides are challenging with spectacular scenery along the way.

Cycle & wine: You can also enjoy flat 4km cycle trip to Springfontein Winery for tastings.

Guided Nature Walk

R 150 PP per hour

The Cape Floral Kingdom is a true wonder of the world, having the richest density of plant species on earth - over 9,000 species and over 6,000 occurring nowhere else on earth. Mosaic offers walks with expert guides along the lagoon edge and wetlands to discover intricate plant-animal relationships and the importance of conserving this unique floral kingdom. A minimum charge of 4 guests applies.

Kayaking

R 100 PP per hour (included for guest staying on Mosaic)

Glide in a kayak on the lagoon to encounter the stunning blue cranes and water birds in our natural wetland, which is a proclaimed bird sanctuary.
